The ICCC conference has been held since 2010 in France, the UK, and New Zealand and has grown into a medium-sized biennial conference attracting an average attendance of 180 conference delegates. It is recognized worldwide as a cutting-edge event on the cold chain addressing the ever-increasing demand for knowledge-sharing in this essential sector.

ICCC2018 will spotlight cold chain and sustainability in refrigeration, air conditioning and heat pumps. Abstracts

Authors are kindly requested to submit an abstract of approximately 150 words in English. The abstract should contain:

- 1) title of the paper;
- 2) authors' name and affiliation;
- 3) paper abstract;
- 4) keywords;
- 5) name, full address, phone number and email address of the author to whom subsequent correspondence should be directed.

The abstract should include the objectives, results, and conclusion. All full papers will be peer-reviewed and the accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings that will be published in bound volumes available after the conference.
